Payment Options for 2025 School Fees & Levies

Option 1: **PAY IN FULL** by 28th February 2025 and receive a 5% discount off your total family fees (excluding levies).

Option 2: **DIRECT DEBIT ARRANGEMENT – PAYABLE OVER 8 MONTHS**

Payments will be debited from your nominated credit card or bank account monthly from February 2025 and ending in September 2025. A new form will need to be completed for your 2025 fees. These forms can be collected from the office or are available to download on our school website and **must be submitted by the 20th February 2025**.

Please note that current payment plans **DO NOT** rollover each year, you **MUST** complete a new one for your 2025 fees.

Option 3: **BY INSTALLMENTS – PAYABLE OVER TERMS 1, 2 AND 3.**

Payments can be made to our school bank account using EFT, BPAY, Direct Debit or Cash directly to the school office. Your account details can be found at the bottom of your statements and will remain the same for the duration of your child's schooling at St Anthony's. These installments are due by the end of each term and are as follows:

- Term 1 installment - Due by Friday 4th April 2025
- Term 2 installment - Due by Friday 4th July 2025
- Term 3 installment - Due by Friday 19th September 2025

NOTE: If you hold a current Health Care Card, you may be eligible for CSEF and Concessional School Fees.
